beneath the furnaces...

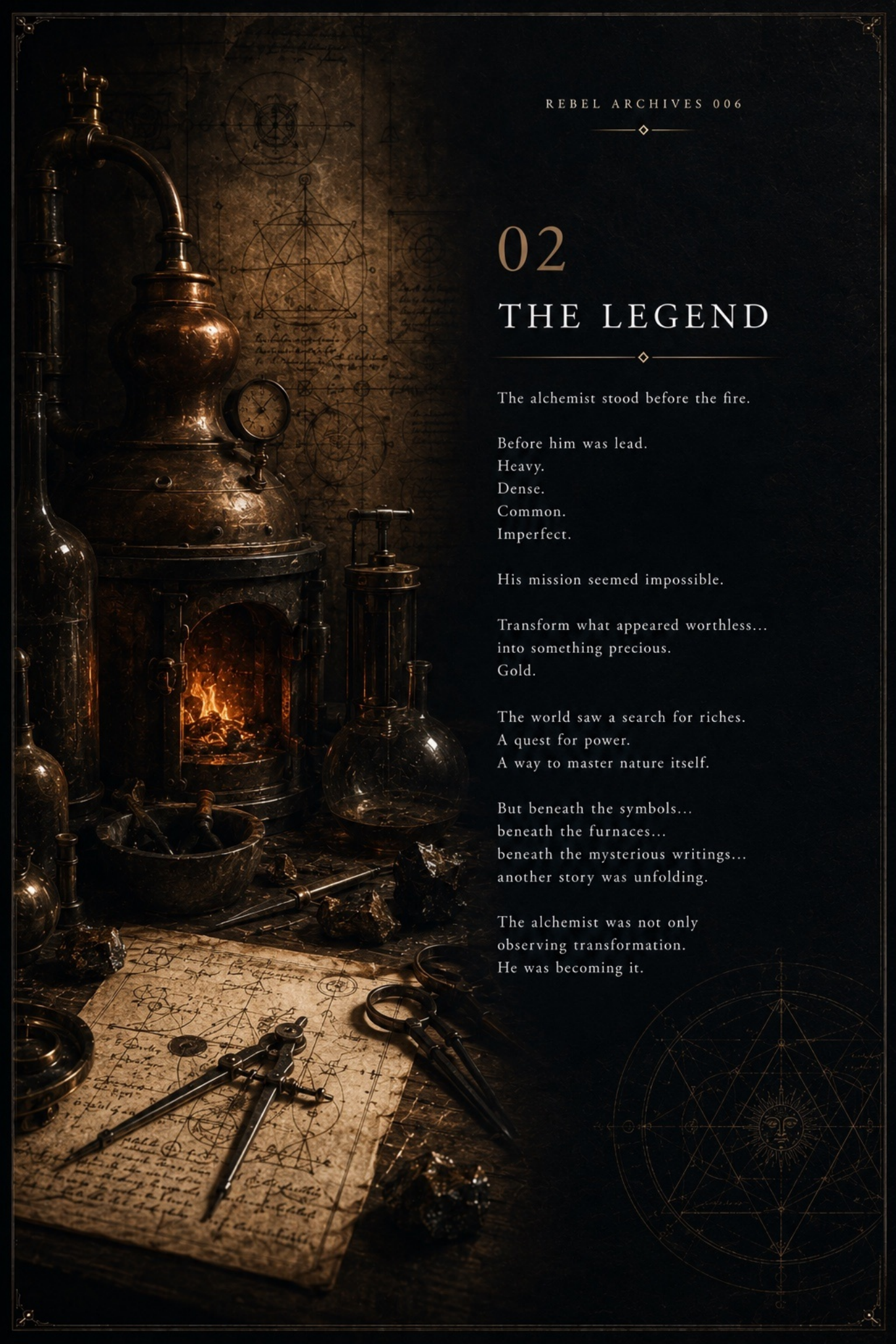
beneath the mysterious writings...

never truly part of us.

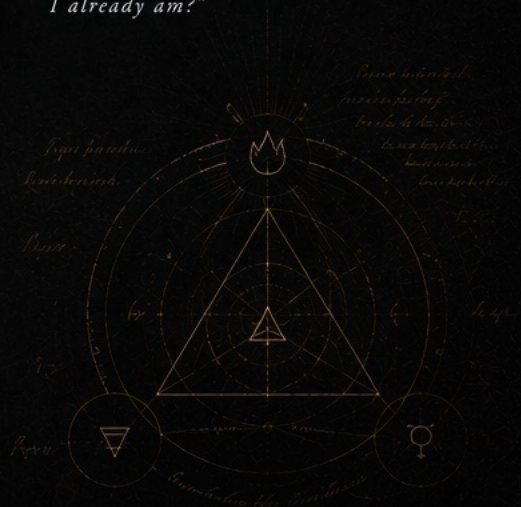
The illusions.
