the ability to see.

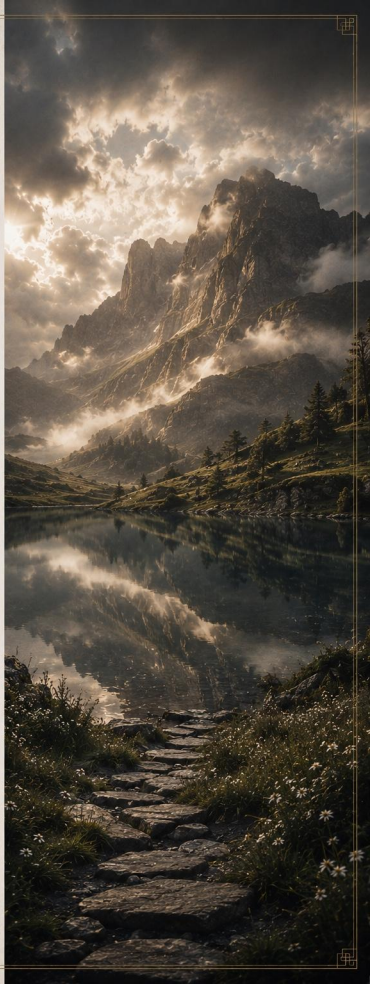
They are not the same.

It is remembered.*

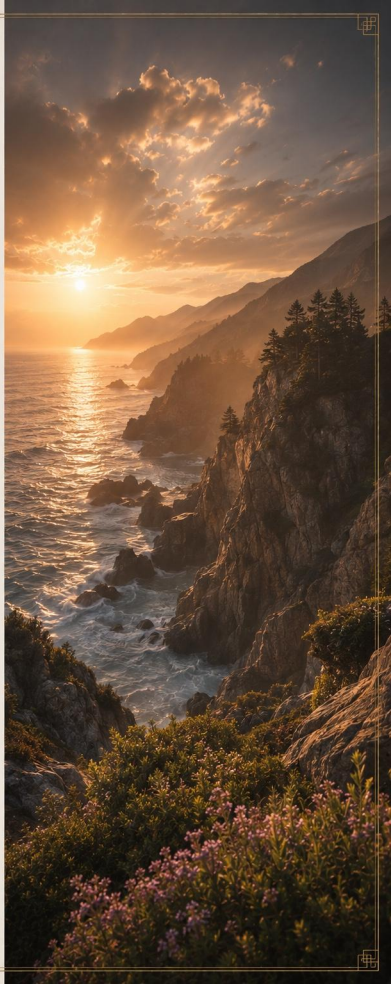

from within.*

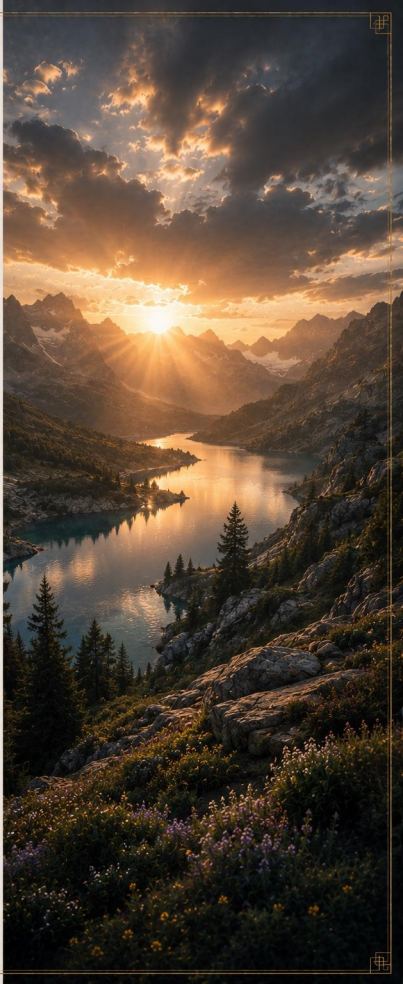
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*Eden was never lost.
